Conditions of Use During COVID 19

The following updates and changes are in addition to Boulder UK's existing centre Conditions of Use and have been implemented to ensure our premises is Covid secure and to limit the spread of the virus. Customers who do not adhere to these changes may be asked to leave.

Customer should:

- Not use the centre if you show any signs or symptoms of Covid-19
- Stay 1 metre plus away from other customers and staff at all times and follow standard climbing wall etiquette.
- Use hand sanitiser before entering the centre and before leaving. Hand sanitizing stations will be available at the entrance and exit.
- Follow the 2 metre floor markings where people queue such as on the pavement when arriving at the centre to check in and for the toilets and café area.
- Pay via credit/debit card to reduce contact with money – memberships and passes are also recommended for purchase to reduce waiting times at reception.
- Be aware that the centre has a maximum capacity size of 80 customers at any one time and should check in at reception upon arrival and sign out at the exit before leaving.
- Pay attention to signage around the centre regarding 1-way systems that are in place.
- Be aware that the maximum number of people allowed in the training area at anyone time is 9.

Toilets & Changing facilities

- Toilets will have a 2 person capacity and customers should adhere to government hand washing protocols after using the facilities.
- The changing facilities will be closed and customers should come ready to climb.
- Climbing shoes should not be worn in the toilets.

Guest Climbers, Juniors and spectators

- Only experienced and registered climbers will be able to access the centre and may only supervise 1 guest climber.
- No spectators will be allowed in the centre during public times.
- Only registered junior climbers (aged 14+, Academy & GB Members) may climb unsupervised.
- All other registered junior climbers may climb under the supervision of a centre instructor or registered climber.

Group Use

- Groups should contact the centre for further details about booking
- External instructors will be required to pre book with a maximum ratio of 1:4

Other Recommendations

- Customers must NOT park in the middle of the compound before 5pm mid-week and can park on the nearby roads outside of the compound.
- Customers will be expected to limit their stay at the wall to 2.5 hours.
- Bring your own drinking flask for tea/coffee from our cafe
- Customers should self-police social distancing rules
- Allow for your locations settings on your smartphone so that customers can check Google Popular times before visiting the centre.
